* Language Requirements in order to study at the University of Granada: 1. Official Language Proficiency Certificate in Spanish Language. Level: B2 within the

Common European Framework of Reference for Languages or similar

This document has to be issued by an Official Language School, University or equivalent and has to state the level of proficiency the student holds in Spanish Language (e.g. DELE Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera = Diploma of Spanish as a Foreign Language of the Cervantes Institute).

2. In the lack of an official language certificate and in case the student has received Spanish language courses at his/her university of origin the student should either request:

2.a) A Transcript of Records in English or Spanish from his/her Faculty that certifies

- the level of Spanish
- the total number of teaching hours
- the credits achieved
- and the results achieved clearly demonstrated.

The Transcript of Records should be duly **signed and sealed**.

2.b) A Certificate in English or Spanish from the Languages Department of the university of origin certifying:

- the students level of Spanish
- the total number of teaching hours received
- the credits achieved
- and the results clearly demonstrated.

This certificate should be **duly signed and sealed**.

In case the language of instruction at the host university is the mother tongue of the candidate, then the student would have to write a letter stating that condition.

This could be an example:

"I, (your name) hereby confirm that (.....) is my mother tongue"
